

Lodz Police [Poland]



From basic warning to inter-vehicle communication

At their new Command and Control Center, Polish Police in Lodz installed a highly advanced police system for communication with patrol officers to control and dynamically localize all vehicles, forces and incident locations.

The purpose of the large screen display is to provide situational awareness of key events, or critical data to the operators. During normal operations, the supervisor (Traffic Dispatcher) may select between a range of graphical information like GIS map of Lodz that identifies unit locations and incident locations or a number of Computer Aided Dispatching screens which are displayed on the separate operator's monitors. Up to 9 video images from any of the 23 traffic cameras located in most important places in Lodz can be selected.

The same solution has been implemented in the Command and Control Center in Warsaw Police.
